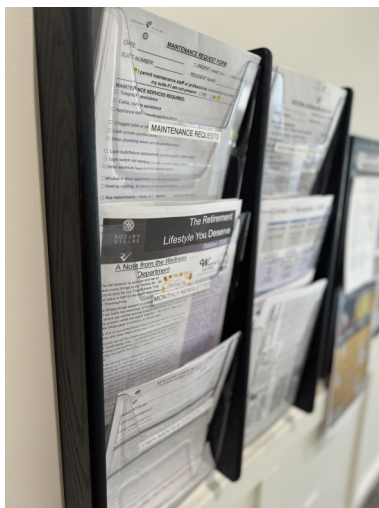
How the Car Plug-Ins Work

"IPLC's microprocessor measures both temperate and windchill and is factory programmed to deliver no power above -5°C . It infinitely varies power delivery from 10 percent on-time at -5°C to 100 percent on-time at -25°C . Once the IPLC first detects a functioning block heater, it cuts power for the first two hours, recognizing how long it will take a hot engine to cool to a temperature requiring block-heater support.

Before plugging in your car, ensure that the green light is flashing slowly. After plugging in, this green light should be lit solid and should remain solid.

Note regarding vehicles with sensor plugs (ie GM, Chevrolet, Pontiac, etc.): These sensor plugs are designed to allow power flow to the vehicle at temperatures -18°C or lower. If the outside temperature is warmer than this when you plug in your vehicle, the green light will remain flashing same as prior to plugging in. When the temperature reaches -18°C the green light will turn solid confirming a load is attached.

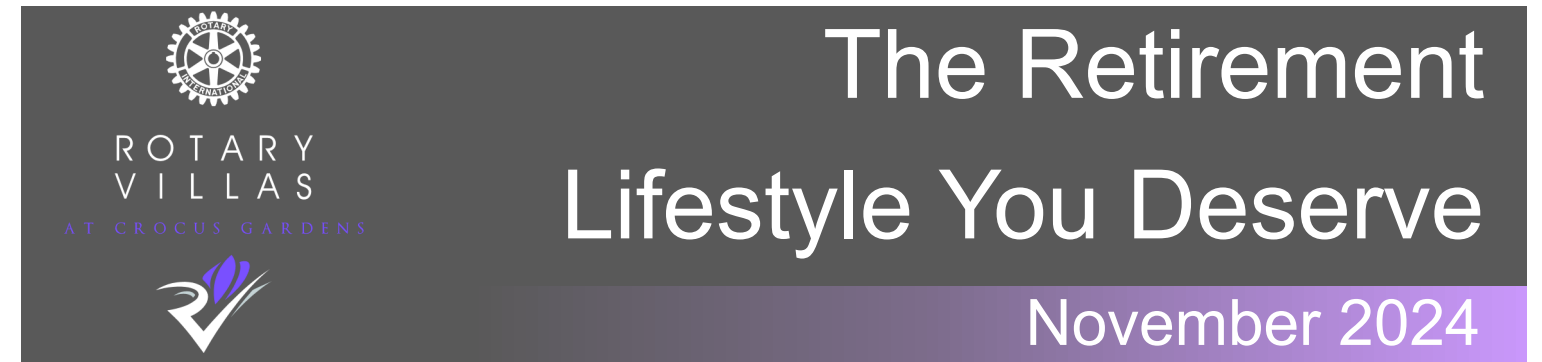
Maintenance Requests
