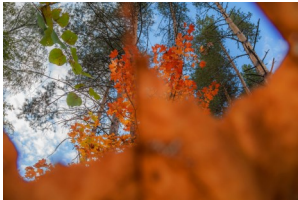

A Note from The Wellness

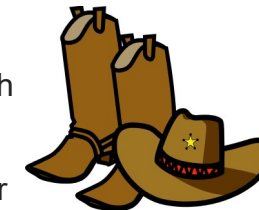
Giddy Up and welcome to September!
